- 1.1 TOPICS – Parts of the body; health problems and advice; medications.
- 1.2 SPEAKING – Describing health problems; talking about common medications; giving advice for health problems.
- 1.3 GRAMMAR – Have + noun; feel + adjective; negative and positive adjectives; imperatives.

### Unit 2 – How do I get there?

- 2.1 TOPICS – Stores and things you can buy there; tourist attractions.
- 2.2 SPEAKING – Talking about stores and other places; asking for and giving directions.
- 2.3 GRAMMAR – Prepositions of place: on, on the corner of, across from, next to, between; giving directions with imperatives.

### Unit 3 – I had a good time

- 3.1 TOPICS – Weekends; chores and fun activities; vacations; summer activities.
- 3.2 SPEAKING – Asking for and giving information about weekend and vacation activities.
- 3.3 GRAMMAR – Simple past statements with regular and irregular verbs; simple past yes/no questions and short answers.

### Unit 4 – Where were you born?

- 4.1 TOPICS – Biographical information; years; school days.
- 4.2 SPEAKING – Asking and giving information about date and place of birth; describing school experiences and memories.
- 4.3 GRAMMAR – Statements and questions with the past of be; Wh-questions with did, was, and were.

### Unit 5 – Can I take a message?

- 5.1 TOPICS – Locations; telephone calls; invitations; going out with friends.
- 5.2 SPEAKING – Describing people's locations; making phone calls; leaving phone messages; making, accepting, and declining invitations; making excuses.



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5.3 GRAMMAR – Prepositional phrases; subject and object pronouns; invitations with Do you want to...? and Would you like to...?; verb + to.
